

Turma Aqua Go Start Up Tip:

The Truma Aqua Go will give you a W27 upon start up after bringing back into service from a drained or winterized state. This code represents the circulation pump is running dry (on the appliance, not the camper water pump).

Truma Aqua Go (the appliance) start up from a drained/winterized state:

1. De-winterize as per procedure previously supplied by us.
2. Once ALL plumber's antifreeze has been displaced with fresh water and the Aqua Go has been valved into service, then go to next step.
3. Ensure the propane bottle is hooked up and open.
4. Remove sink drain cap.
5. Turn on appliance ("on" switch in down position on the outside of the appliance).
6. Turn on camper water pump power
7. Valve sink to hot water position
8. Air will be coming out of faucet, which will trigger a W27 code on the Truma Control Screen
9. Perform a reset to clear the code (as per Truma Manual)
10. Repeat step 7, if more air comes out and triggers the code - perform step 9
11. Repeat until the tap flows hot water, meaning the appliance has successfully fired. This can happen more than once; we have seen up to 1-5 times.
