

Acrylic Window Maintenance & Care

Following these simple steps will ensure long service life from your acrylic windows.

- Always rinse abrasive dust from the window before cleaning.
- Never use glass cleaner to clean acrylic unless it specifically says it is meant for acrylic.
- Ammonia based cleaners are especially damaging.
- A better solution is a few drops of dish washing liquid in water. Dry with a soft towel or chamois.
- Automated car washes should be avoided due to the possible abrasives in the wash wheels. These are not so good for your paint either!
- We recommend Novus brand plastic cleaners and polishes
- Novus 1 is for day-to-day cleaning. It leaves a bright, static free surface that resists fogging and fingerprints
- Novus 2 is for polishing out fine scratches. It should always be followed by Novus 1
- Novus 3 is for removing deeper scratches. It should always be followed Novus 1 and 2
